Chittagong Eye Infirmary and Trining Complex (CEITC)

Chittagong Eye Infirmary is located in southeastern region of Bangladesh built over a sprawling eight acres of land in the picturesque area of Chittagong city, the hospital serves as one of the major referral and human resource development centre of the country. The campus besides having 130 bed Eye Hospital also houses the Institute of Community Ophthalmology, essential staff accommodation and other ancillary facilities occupying a floor area of 16,000 sq.m.



CEITC provide eye services through Hospital and various outreach programs such as Mobile Eye Camp, School Eye Heath Services, Primary Eye Care Services and Under Five Clinic services.

It provide 500-600 OPD consultation daily through routine OPD services along with subspecialty services such as Glaucoma, Cornea-Eye Bank, Ocular

Microbiology, Vitreao-Retina, Paediatric Ophthalmology, Neuro-Ophthalmology, Orbit-Oculoplasty, Low Vision etc.

There are well equipped six modern surgical rooms at CEITC of which three are dedicated for posterior segment, paediatric ophthalmology and extraocular cases.

With the support of ORBIS International a separate **Paediatric Ophthalmology Department** established in 2002.



Paediatric Ophthalmology OPD There is a separate well equipped out patient wing for paediatric ophththalmology, six consultation rooms – two for paediatric ophthalmologist, one for orthoptic, one for paediatric refraction, one for paediatric counselling and one for paediatrician. There is separate registration room for children. A cheerful safe wide child play area and a separate feeding room for mother to feed their babies.

Paediatric ophthalmology department provide eye care services to 25,000 patients in OPD and performed 800 surgeries in a year.

There is a separate 16 bed child ward.. Admitted patients are take care by trained nurse round the clock.

There are well equipped 6 modern surgical rooms at CEITC, one for paediatric ophthalmology with all essential equipments for paediatric ophthalmology surgery including teaching devices, 3 modern anaesthesia machine with well trained

supporting staff. Annually over 800 ophthalmic surgeries for children including cataract, glaucoma, strabismus, trauma, lacrimal, lid and orbital procedures are performed

There is a growing demand from different Institution within the country to use existing Paediatric Ophthalmology facilities for their human resource development and ORBIS International would also like to use these facilities for the benefit of other Institutions, and like to see Paediatric Ophthalmology Department of CEITC as a National resource centre. CEITC management has decided to start a formal training program on Paediatric Ophthalmology in a regular fashion with the support of ORBIS International and in this respect a curriculum for different courses have been developed.
